Acknowledge the Program Diversity

Use community building activities that explore various backgrounds, identities, and experiences youth bring to help promote a sense of belonging

Communicate and model your own personal equity traits like openness, fairness, and approachability to make youth feel more comfortable when approaching equity-related discussions and issues

Listen for Teachable Moments around Equity

Consistently call-in those whose behavior conveys bias or promotes exclusion to create learning opportunities
